

Our troop maintains the trail behind Chaparral Elementary School every month. When it is your patrol's turn to do trail maintenance, your patrol must go to the trail and maintain your assigned section.

Your responsibilities include making sure that the trail is free of litter and debris, as well as overgrowing plants. Your patrol should do maintenance of some form for at least an hour. Attendance by everyone in the patrol is mandatory.

I suggest that you bring equipment such as hedge clippers, rakes, trash bags, gloves, saws, and machetes, as well as drinking water.

Additionally, you must contact your patrol and make sure they know where and when they are supposed to meet, as well as what they should bring.

Traditionally, trail maintenance is done on the second Saturday of the month after newspapers (around 2:00 pm). However, as long as it gets done during the assigned month, I will allow some flexibility.
